Boundary Maintenance at Carlyle Lake

Carlyle Lake – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Carlyle Lake will be performing boundary maintenance work from December 20TH through January 14TH, 2011 on a section of the boundary line at Carlyle Lake. The area scheduled to be maintained will begin at South Shore State Park and continue towards the Boulder Recreation Area.

The boundary line maintenance work will consist of uniformed Park Rangers walking the boundary lines and clearing brush along the boundary line, replacing signposts, and identifying encroachments on government property. The maintenance work is performed annually during the winter months when vegetation is at a minimum. Boundary line maintenance is necessary in order to maintain a visible boundary line and to protect public lands around Carlyle Lake.
