


Public Notice

Project Summary: The City of Belleville, Illinois is developing a new maintenance campus on nineteen acres of property located along Illinois Route 13, Old Freeburg Road, Belleville, St. Clair County, Illinois. The Maintenance Campus will be built in phases. The first phase was completed in 2008 consisting of a new parking lot and salt dome storage building. Phase 2 is the current development request, including additional parking, additional buildings, vehicle fueling location and material storage facilities. The City proposes dredging an existing 6.51 acre emergent wetland for material for the required fill to develop the site infrastructure. The City is proposing to converted the wetland into a pond. The City is considering mitigation at numerous sites and possible wetland banks.


Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 8 West, 3rd Principal Meridian 650
