River and Harbor Acts of 1927 and 1930

Location and Description:

The portion of the Illinois Waterway within the boundaries of the St. Louis District extending from the mouth of the Illinois River at Grafton, Illinois, to the tailwater of LaGrange Lock and Dam at mile 80.15. The project maintains a nine-foot navigation channel by dredging/channel patrol, water management, environmental compliance, and river engineering. The project has stewardship responsibility for 16,000 acres of public lands.



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
