When can MDNR expect to get the regulators review copy of the FS/PP? MDNR expects to still receive a 30-day review period from the date of receipt of the document.	MDNR can expect to receive the regulator review of the FS/PP in January. The North County Site FS/PP is currently undergoing legal review by the USACE HTRW-CX Office of Counsel, a process mandated by HQUSACE. Upon receipt and resolution of comments by this office, the St. Louis District will request HQUSACE approval to release the documents to the regulators for review. Once HQUSACE provides the approval to release the document, MDNR will be afforded a 30-day review of the North County Site FS/PP from the time of receipt.
MDNR is requesting another copy of the FS/PP and ROD schedule for the North County Sites. Please provide a copy of the FS/PP ROD schedule for the North County Sites along with the Regulator Review copy of the document.	The schedule for the North County Site FS/PP ROD is the same that was issued to MDNR, USEPA and USACE at the August 13, 1998 meeting. A North County ROD schedule will be provided as soon as practicable after it is updated.
USACE is collecting a large amount of data every day from all of the sites. Lack of accessibility to the data for the USACE or regulators is an issue that must be addressed. How is this data being managed by USACE contractors?	The collecting USACE contractors are maintaining field data in their respective databases. Additionally, data required for environmental documentation and compliance is integrated into the project data repository.
MDNR expects the USACE to fully brief the St. Louis Remediaton Oversight Committee on the Feasibility Study and Proposed Plan in a timely manner before the public hearing or comment period. Members of the Oversight Committee represent many groups that will be affected by the final remedy outlined in the FS/PP.	Concur.
