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

SUBJECT: Installation Restoration Program Management for the Iowa AAP

1. After carefully reviewing Iowa AAP's installation restoration program and schedule management support arrangement I am transferring responsibility for program and schedule management from the Omaha District to the St. Louis District Corps of Engineers.
2. My decision is based on the assessment that the St. Louis District is best qualified to manage the full range of programmatic and scheduling issues confronting the Iowa AAP Installation Restoration Program. Due to the high visibility, political sensitivity and the magnitude of the FUSRAP program relative to the environmental restoration account (ER,A) activities, I believe it is in the best interest of the Army for this transfer to occur immediately.
3. Until further notice, this transition will not discontinue technical execution of current phase environmental restoration account (ER,A) eligible funded or to be funded clean up activities currently being accomplished by the Omaha Corps of Engineers. This includes current Army explosive contamination clean up of soil and groundwater associated with IAAAP.
4. All clean up work involving DOE radiological contaminants or other DOE contaminants will be executed by Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program St. Louis District Corps of Engineers Project Office.
5. As part of the transition, we will not fund URS for Iowa AAP Installation Restoration Program scheduling effort. No further contract actions except the four previously programmed modifications to existing contracts (funding request files 163 through 166) should be undertaken without the express prior approval from the Iowa AAP Commander. All Installation Restoration Program scheduling will be coordinated with and managed by the St. Louis District.
6. I expect to be briefed on the transition plan prior to my departure from Iowa Army Ammunition Plant.
