

As you are aware, the Senate Appropriations Committee has directed the Army Corps of Engineers to report to Congress on the "recommendations regarding a radiological survey of the entire plant site" at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant. Additionally, the Committee directs the Corps to prepare this report "in consultation with the State of Iowa." The Iowa Department of Public Health, specifically the Bureau of Radiological Health representing the state of Iowa, is prepared to assist immediately in any way with the preparation, review and presentation of this report.
