Formal Dispute

Phase 5 Soils Remedial Design Work Plan

- EPA & Army entered into informal dispute in December 2002 regarding the delivery date of the document
- Elevated to the Dispute Resolution Committee in June 2003
- Elevated to the Senior Executive Committee in July 2003
- Currently awaiting resolution which is due October 2003

Performance Based Contracting Mechanism

- **Hires Contractor to reach Environmental Remediation Objectives at the Iowa AAP up to and including Regulatory Closure**
- **Sets Schedule**
- **Transfers Performance Risk to Contractor/Army Retains Liability**
- **May Accelerate Clean**
- **Caps Army Costs and Liability**
