


# FUSRAP AREAS PROPOSED PLAN

for the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), St. Louis District, issued a Proposed Plan summarizing cleanup alternatives and the supporting Feasibility Study for Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) areas at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) on April 22, 2011. The Proposed Plan identifies *Soil Alternative 4, Excavation of Contaminated Soil with Physical Treatment and Off-Site Disposal*, and *Structures Alternative 3, Decontamination/Replacement of Structures*, as the USACE's preferred remedy for the FUSRAP areas.



Soil Alternative 4 and Structures Alternative S3 protect human health and the environment and provide the best balance of effectiveness, cost, and implementability.

## Public Participation

USACE encourages public input to help select one cleanup alternative each for soil and structures in the FUSRAP areas. The final remedy for soil and structures will not be selected until after full consideration of all public and government agency comments. The final remedy will be documented in a Record of Decision for the FUSRAP areas at the IAAAP.
