TRANSIT ADVISORY Above Lock 24, UMR Mile 275.0 - 274.0

- 1. Mariners should exercise caution if waiting along the right descending bank from mile 275.0 to mile 274.0 for lockage at Lock 24. A new survey was performed on 10 July 2017, showing similar results to previous surveys; a shoal of less than 9-ft of depth, at minimum pool, starts 250-ft right of the sailing.
- 2. From mile 275.0 to 274.0, the Navigation Channel is over 600-ft wide and at least 11-ft deep at minimum pool.

- 4. All navigation interest should be alert for, and abide by, any special instructions that may be issued by the Lockmaster.
