CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING USACE Dredge Potter Upper Mississippi River mile 0 - 300

- 1. Commencing on 10 July 2017 and continuing until further notice, the US Army Corps of Engineers Dredge Potter will perform channel maintenance dredging at various locations on the Upper Mississippi River from mile 0 to 300.0.
- 2. The USACE Dredge Potter is expected to complete work at Lock and Dam 25, mile 242 243 UMR, this afternoon 24 July 2017. The next work assignments are as follows:
 - 1. Mile 227 UMR, 25 26 July 2017.
 - 2. Mile 241.5 240 UMR, 27 30 July 2017.
 - 3. Mile 266.3 UMR, 31 July 1 Aug 2017.
- 3. The Dredge Potter and its attendant plant, to include tender boats, small boats, barges and pipeline, etc., will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When dredging, removed material is pumped through a pontoon pipeline or self floating pipeline, which may be crossing the channel, and is placed outside of the navigation channel.
- 4. The Dredge Potter may be contacted on VHF-FM radio channels 13 and 16. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made with the Dredge Potter.
