
## CHANNEL CONDITION ADVISORY Alton, IL Upper Mississippi River mile 203.6 - 202.8

- A new channel condition survey, collected on 26 April 2017, is available for Alton, IL, mile 203.6 202.8 UMR. Depths shown on the survey are at minimum pool, which is 414.0 at Alton, mile 203.0 UMR. The results of the survey are attached.
- 2. On 27 April 2017 the USACE Pathfinder added a green buoy at mile 203.4 and a red buoy at mile 203.1, on the 8.7-ft soundings shown on the survey. The best available channel is to the right descending side of the sailing line.
