CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING USACE Dredge Potter St. Louis District

- Commencing on 27 July 2018 and continuing until further notice, the US Army Corps of Engineers Dredge Potter will perform channel maintenance dredging at various locations within the St. Louis District.
- 2. The Dredge Potter completed work in the vicinity of mile 223 UMR on Sunday, 26 August 2018.
- 3. The Dredge Potter is now working at mile 227 UMR, with an estimated completion of 28 August 2018.
- 4. The Dredge Potter's next assignments will be at mile 235 UMR, with an estimated completion of 30 August, followed by mile 240 UMR with an estimated completion of 2 September.
- 5. The Dredge Potter and its attendant plant, to include tender boats, small boats, barges and pipeline, etc., work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When dredging, removed material is pumped through a pontoon pipeline or self-floating pipeline, which may be crossing the channel, and is placed outside of the navigation channel.
- 6. The Dredge Potter may be contacted on VHF-FM radio channels 13 and 16. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made with the Dredge Potter.
