LOCKAGE & CREW CHANGE SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS (COVID-19) Lock and Dam 24 and 25 Upper Mississippi River Mile 273.4 and 241.4

NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS

Due to concerns regarding the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and effective immediately for MISSISSIPPI RIVER LOCKS 24 and 25:

- 1. No industry personnel shall be allowed inside USACE lock control houses or other buildings during crew changes, except in the case of medical emergency.
- 2. Crew changes will still be allowed, but industry personnel must go directly from the vehicle to the motor vessel. At both facilities (Locks 24/25) the crew van will be required to park outside of the exterior fenced area during the crew change.
- 3. Also effective immediately Locks 24 and 25 will not accept incoming or outgoing boat mail.
- 4. Industry personnel will be required to use their own facilities while navigating through the lock.
- 5. Changes are effective immediately and until further notice.
- 6. All navigation interest should be alert for, and abide by, any special instructions that may be issued by the Lockmaster.
