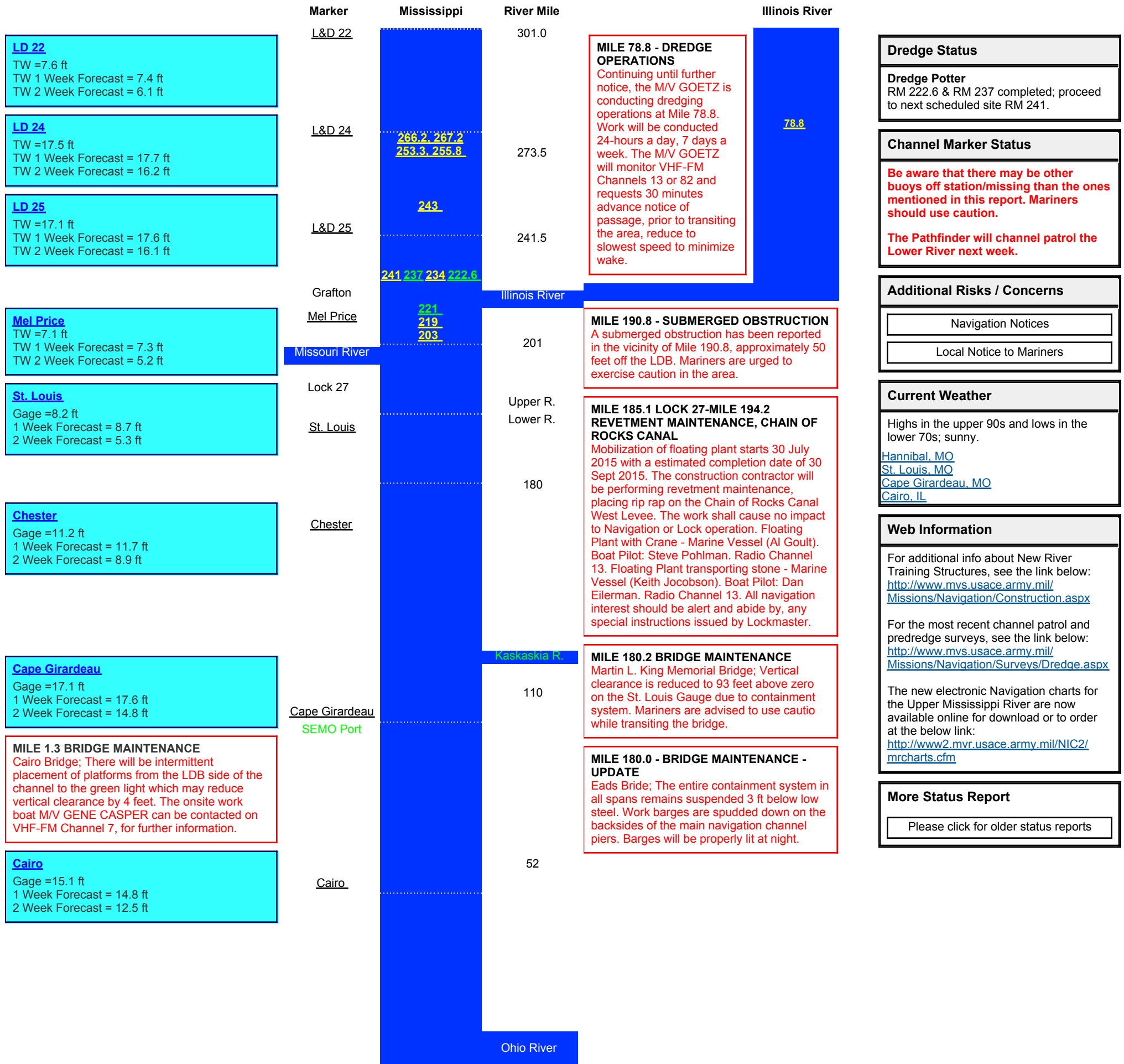


Navigation Channel Condition Status Report - 03 September 2015
