

Melvin Price/Wood River Seepage Cut-Off Wall Project

Project Summary

The project consists of the construction of an 8,100 lineal feet seepage cut-off wall to approximate depths of 135 to 165 feet. The project is located adjacent to and upstream of the Melvin Price Locks and Dam in Alton, IL and will address underseepage occurring along this Wood River Levee reach.

Earliest Contract Advertising date is July 15, 2014 and is subject to funding availability.



Purpose
