Lake Shelbyville's Closing and Extended Open Dates for Campgrounds

Lake Shelbyville – U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announces the season closing and extended open dates for the following campgrounds at Lake Shelbyville:

- Lithia Springs Campground closes for the season Sunday, October 28, 2012
- Bo Wood Campground closes for the season Sunday, October 28, 2012 except for campsites 114 through 141, which close Monday, December 3, 2012.
- Lone Point Campground closed for the season on Tuesday, September 4, 2012 except for campsites 86 through 95, which close Monday, December 3, 2012.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be keeping Lone Point Recreation Area campsites 86 through 95 and Bo Wood Recreation Area campsites 114 through 141 open until Monday, December 3, 2012. Camping at Lone Point sites will be \$16.00 per night for each campsite and \$18.00-\$24.00 per night for each campsite at Bo Wood. These campsites will be available on a first-come first-served individual site basis. There will be no reservations available for these sites. A self deposit vault will be located near the entrance to sites with directions explaining the process for paying your camping fee and to provide a payment tag for your campsite post. Electricity will be available at these sites. Water and flush toilets will be available until early November. After that the water will be shut off to winterize the facilities and porta potties will be available.
