

## Under the Levee

### Coordinates

### Short Description:

This is one of a series of caches that will be hidden by Park Rangers of the US Army Corp of Engineers. It is located near the National Great Rivers Museum and is also near the MCT Confluence bike trail.

### Long Description

The US Army Corps of Engineers was first called upon to address flood problems along the Mississippi river in the mid- 1800's. We began work on the Mississippi River and Tributaries Flood Control Project in 1928, and the Flood Control Act of 1936 gave the Corps the mission to provide flood protection to the entire country.

Urban levees are built very high to protect cities and towns against floods of great magnitude. Agricultural levees are smaller levees that provide relatively lower levels of protection to millions of acres of cropland against more frequent, less severe floods.
