**PUBLIC NOTICE ANNOUNCING SECTION 401 WATER  
QUALITY CERTIFICATION FOR SELECTED  
NATIONWIDE PERMITS IN MISSOURI**

On November 28, 2003, the Mississippi Valley Division Engineer accepted modified Section 401 Water Quality Certifications with conditions from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources for Nationwide Permits (NWP) 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14, 18, 27, 33, 36, 40, 41, 42, and 43. These conditions apply to all activities authorized by these NWPs. Regional conditions were approved on May 17, 2002, to provide additional protection for the aquatic environment by ensuring that the NWPs authorize only those activities with minimal adverse effects on the aquatic environment. Regional conditions will help ensure protection of high value waters within the District.
