Lake Shelbyville No Hunting Boundaries Being Updated and Painted

Lake Shelbyville – The Environmental Stewardship section is currently in the process of updating the 600 Foot No Hunting boundaries around all Recreation Areas on Lake Shelbyville. The update consists of adjusting the boundaries in areas where new campsites or facilities have been added, adequately signing the perimeter of the buffer, and painting the perimeter with yellow paint. The boundaries have not been updated in a few years and a few changes are expected. For example, with the addition of Area 4 campsites in Forrest W. Bo Wood Campground, the No Hunting Boundary will shift to the north to bring the park into compliance with the 600 foot safety zone. Maps of the No Hunting Boundaries will be added to the Lake Shelbyville website as the field work is completed and can be viewed at www.mvs.usace.army.mil/Shelbyville/wildlife.htm under the No Hunting Boundary maps as they become available.
