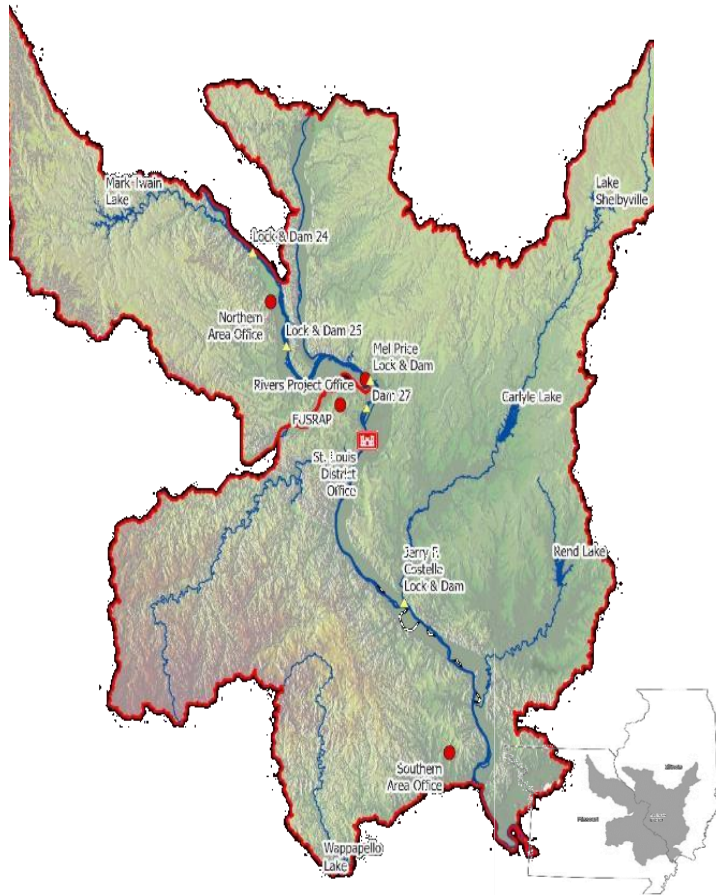




# St. Louis District Mission – Value to the Nation

**IIJA: \$732M** is for the NESP L25 new 1200ft Lock project. NESP, or Navigation and Ecosystem Sustainability Program, is an authorized, multi- purpose program that contains projects across three USACE districts (MVP, MVR, MVS) to get at improved Navigation Efficiency and additional Ecosystem Restoration on the Upper Mississippi and Illinois Rivers. High points of the program include 7 new 1200ft locks at existing facilities. L25 is the first of those new locks to be funded. Initial construction industry engagement on the plan for delivering the 1200ft Lock and L25 will take place via an initial focused industry day event in June 2022. Look for follow up notifications on this event in the coming weeks.
