The data are from the 2000 Demographic Profile and the 1990 Summary Tape File 1 produced by the U.S. Census Bureau. Some differences in data variables are presented by the two source data packages. For example, race was reported for four identified categories plus an "other" category in 1990. In 2000, respondents to the census questionnaire were allowed to report multiple races. In the race tables, these differences are accommodated by using the categories of 1990 plus a category of "Hawaiian" and a category of "two+ races" to accommodate the multiple race categories for 2000. These corresponding fields are flagged with "NA" for 1990. Another example of variable differences is found in "household relationship" and "household type." In these instances, common variables between the two packages were included. The 2000 "with own children under 18 years" variable was paired with the 1990 "with related children" variable.

Racial categories are abbreviated for spatial efficiency. "Black" represents "Black or African American." "Indian" connotes "American Indian and Alaska Native." "Asian" comprises "Asian Indian," "Chinese," "Filipino," "Japanese," "Korean," "Vietnamese" and "Other Asian." "Hawaiian" includes "Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander," consisting of four subcategories. "Other" means not elsewhere classified.

Tables presenting percentages may not always sum to 100, due to rounding by the one-point decimal precision level. The Hispanic category is an ethnic classification, not a racial group. Hispanic population may be any race. Its numbers are not included when summing racial categories to total population.
