This is in regard to your April 17, 1992, letter, concerning the St. Louis Site, located in St. Louis, Missouri.

On April 23, 1992, representatives of Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) visited our office. We provided them with copies of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's National Wetland Inventory maps that cover the project area. We directed these representatives to the Missouri Department of Conservation headquarters in Jefferson City to obtain a complete listing of federally and state-listed endangered, threatened, and rare species that may occur in the project area.

We are mailing a comprehensive list of animal species that are known or suspected to occur in St. Louis County to SAIC. Also, we have suggested that general information regarding vegetative communities may be obtained in a publication entitled The Terrestrial Natural Communities of Missouri by Paul W. Nelson.

We appreciate your concern for sensitive fish and wildlife resources in Missouri. We look forward to future coordination with you and SAIC during preparation of the Feasibility Study-Environmental Impact Statement for the St. Louis Site.
