

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

CITY OF HAZELWOOD

February 8, 1993

CALL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Hazelwood City Council in conjunction with the Berkeley City Council and representatives of the Department of Energy was called to order by Mr. David Adler, Department of Energy Site Manager, at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, February 8, 1993, at the Department of Energy Information Center, 9200 Latty Avenue, Hazelwood, Missouri.

Council members Ray Rohman and Joseph Eulentrop had advised they would not be present for this meeting. Councilman Richard Martin was absent. Also present were City Manager Edwin G. Carlstrom and City Clerk Norma Caldwell. Berkeley Mayor William Miller, members of the Berkeley City Council, and Berkeley City Manager Arbon Hairston were also present, as well as Department of Energy Site Manager David Adler and several representatives of the Department of Energy.

WASTE REMOVAL

Mr. David Adler advised the Councils of the cost and time factors involved in various alternatives for the removal and storage of the radioactive waste from the Mallinckrodt, Latty Avenue and Airport sites.

One alternative addressed was placing this waste under runways at Lambert-St. Louis International Airport and then paving over it thereby securing the waste and restoring the use of all sites. Another alternative, Mr. Adler stated, was to move all the waste to the Airport site. This would encroach on the Berkeley ballfields on McDonnell Boulevard. He noted this would result in a very imposing hill of radioactive waste which would then be secured, covered and sodded. The property would be unusable and would be rather unattractive. Alternatives for moving the waste out of this urban area--or out of state--were also discussed.


Data provided by DOE was discussed at length. Mr. Adler reported the work is a little ahead of schedule on this project.
