MINUTES LOCAL PRIORITIES WORKING GROUP

May 24, 1995

SLAPS PROPOSAL. Mr. Binz advised the group the Water Company is going to aggressively oppose the shielding on the SLAPS Site, and reported a meeting is to be held by Metropolitan Sewer District, Union Electric, St. Louis County Water Company, Laclede Gas Company, and Southwestern Bell to discuss common themes that may exist. They will also be addressing dealing with emergency controls. They will possibly be meeting with the DOE. Mr. Binz mentioned the OSHA requirements, e.g. training requirements to work in this type of material. Mr. Binz said the liability issue needs to be clearly understood. Mr. Binz said one option to be considered by the utility companies is the relocation of their lines in the area of the contaminated material.

MATRIX. The group commenced preparing amendments to the MATRIX, and certain changes were made to the first two pages. Those pages, as amended, will be faxed by Ms. Batton to Mr. Frauenhoffer. (Attachment No. 1)
