property for Berkeley. Mr. Dwyer reported  
that Mr. Adler said DOE could only buy land  
for use as a disposal facility, and not for  
recreational use.

Council had discussed the ballfields proposal and was considering a special meeting.

Nancy Lubiewski suggested that the Task Force meet with Berkeley City Council to discuss the ballfields proposal. Ms. Montgomery said she was not sure one meeting would be sufficient to convey all the information about the proposal. Mr. Dwyer said he would assist in any communication efforts with the City of Berkeley.
