The next meeting of the St. Louis Site Remediation Task Force is scheduled for 7:30 a.m. on December 12, 1995 at the Hazelwood Civic Center East, 8969 Dunn Road. The meeting is open to the public, and I have enclosed an agenda and a map indicating the meeting location for your information.

I also have enclosed the summary highlights of the November Task Force meeting for your review.

As you may be aware, the St. Louis Site Remediation Task Force was formed in late 1994 to develop a public consensus about cleanup solutions and future courses of action at four groups of properties in the St. Louis area that are contaminated with low-level radioactive waste. The properties are:

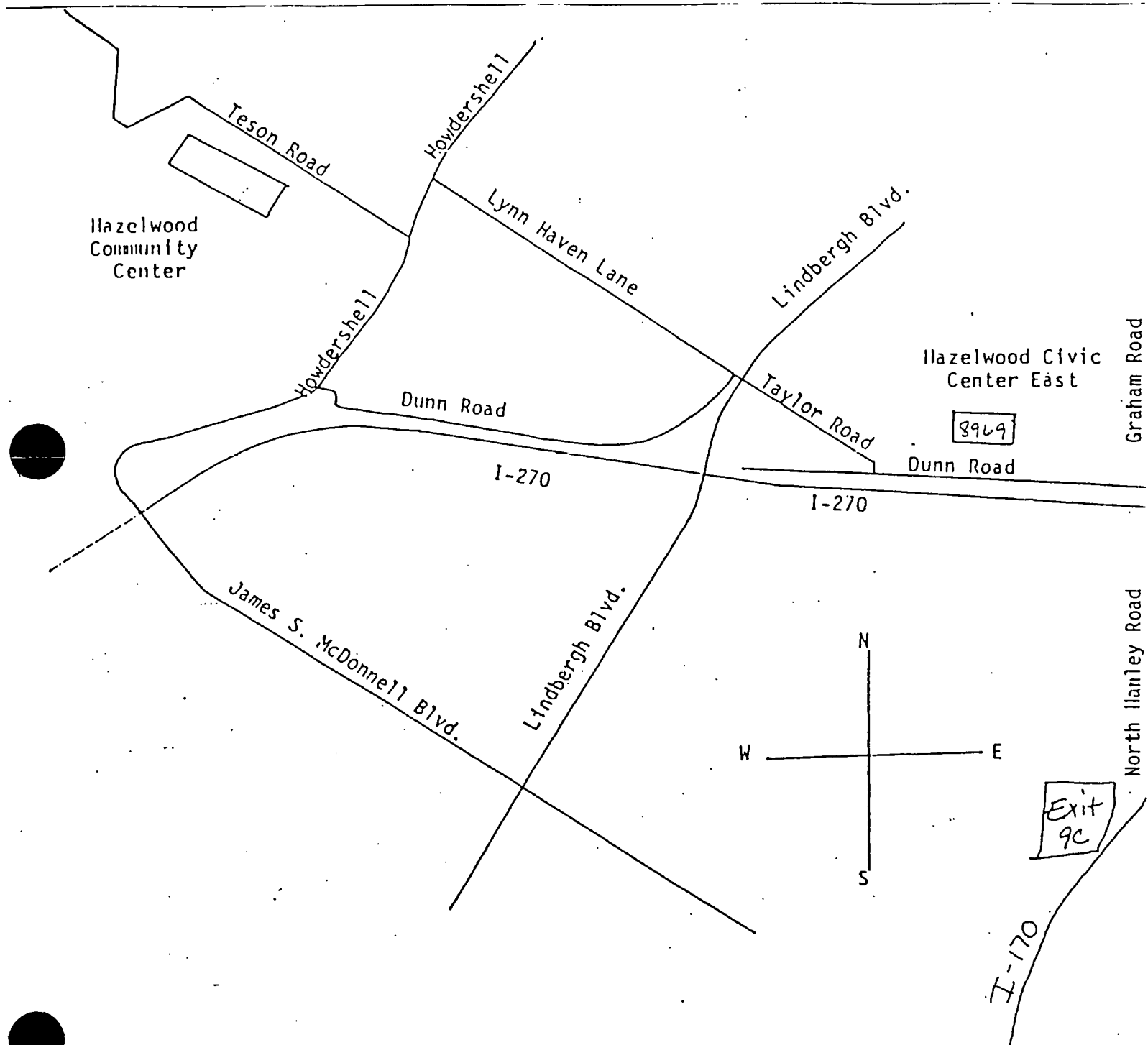
- St. Louis Downtown Site (SLDS)
- St. Louis Airport Site (SLAPS)
- Several nearby, or "vicinity" properties associated with SLAPS
- Latty Avenue Properties, which include the Hazelwood Interim Storage Site (HISS)

Task Force members have been evaluating cleanup and disposal options for more than a year in order to develop recommendations that represent the most feasible and cost-effective disposal alternatives that are protective of human health and the environment. We plan to issue our final report and recommendations to the U.S. Department of Energy next Spring.

SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS

November 14, 1995 Meeting

Background:

The St. Louis Site Remediation Task Force is a citizens advisory group, formed in September 1994, to develop a public consensus about cleanup solutions, waste disposal, and future courses of action at the U.S. Department of Energy's Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) sites in St. Louis.

The group meets at 7:30 a.m. on the second Tuesday of each month at the Hazelwood Civic Center East, 8969 Dunn Road, Hazelwood, Missouri, 63042. Task Force meetings are open to the public.

Highlights of November Meeting:

- Task Force participants were briefed about the status of the Coldwater Creek Panel, a group of six expert geologists and hydrologists who were assembled in October to evaluate existing and potential future impact of contamination from the St. Louis Airport Site (SLAPS) on Coldwater Creek via surface and/or ground water migration. The panel has scheduled its third meeting for 8 a.m. December 13, 1995, at the Stouffer Concourse Hotel, 9801 Natural Bridge Road.

The panel expects to develop its conclusions and present its findings by the January 9, 1996 Task Force meeting.

- The vice chair of the Local Citizens Monitoring Committee for the Dawn Mining Co. facility in Ford, Washington, addressed the Task Force. He told Task Force members that the newly-licensed Dawn Mining facility is seeking low-level radioactive waste, possibly similar to the materials at the St. Louis Site, to be used in closing the mine. Dawn Mining Co.'s closure plan calls for the mine excavations to be filled with low-level radioactive soils.

Key Decisions/Recommendations:

- Task Force members approved a recommendation authorizing the Communications Working Group to conduct several publicity activities,

including notifying the media and stakeholders of meetings.

- The Task Force agreed to firmly establish its membership by the December meeting, as recommended by the Membership Working Group.
- The Task Force agreed to recommend that DOE remediate a commercial property on Hazelwood Avenue during fiscal year 1996 because of a pending sale of the property.
