<i>Call to Order</i>	Jim Dwyer called the meeting to order at approximately 9:30 a.m.	
<i>Evaluation of Dawn Mining Co. Site</i>	<p>The working group met for the sole purposes of evaluating the suitability of the Dawn Mining Co. site as a potential disposal facility for contaminated wastes from the St. Louis FUSRAP Site and developing a report and recommendation for consideration by the Task Force.</p> <p>Utilizing the assumptions and definitions developed earlier by the working group, as well as site-specific information provided by representatives of Dawn, the group assigned "raw ratings" to the Dawn site in each of the evaluation categories described on the working group's matrix.</p>	

Those raw values were then tempered to reflect the "Task Force values." The resulting weighted values yielded a composite rating of 195. Based on those calculations the group determined that the Dawn site should be included in the "suitable site" category, along with the Envirocare site and three DOE facilities located in Nevada, Tennessee and Washington.

Jan Titus agreed to develop a revised matrix to include the Dawn site, and it was agreed that the group's conclusion would be reported to the Task Force at its upcoming meeting.

The meeting adjourned at approximately noon.
