Dear Mr. Wall:

Enclosed for your review is the Calendar Year (CY) 1997 Post Remedial Action Report (PRAR) for the St. Louis Sites (SLS). The remedial action described in this CY 1997 PRAR was initiated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) and was conducted in accordance with the objectives and recommendations of three existing Engineering Evaluation /Cost Analysis (EE/CAs) developed by the DOE. Post remedial action sampling and surveys and IVC verification were conducted by the DOE and its contractors in accordance with existing regulations and procedures. The U. S. Corps of Engineers (USACE) did not re-verify the DOE data nor did it conduct additional surveys of the remediated areas.

Starting with calendar year 1998, PRARs will be reported based on investigation /remediated area rather than on a yearly basis. As the remediation of each area is completed, a separate PRAR will be produced. The PRAR will be forwarded for your review and subsequently included in the Administrative Record for the Site. A draft PRAR for Remedial Action Summary (RAS) is enclosed for your review and comment.
