Army Corps of Engineers as part of the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) has been satisfactorily completed at the location referenced above. This letter has been sent certified mail to assure you are in receipt of this important notification.

The removal action at the referenced location was authorized by and performed according to the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA)-Environmental Assessment for Proposed Decontamination of Properties in the Vicinity of the Hazelwood Interim Storage Sites (HISS), Hazelwood, Missouri - March 1992. Radiological data obtained during this effort have been analyzed and the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers can confirm that radiological contamination above established cleanup levels has been successfully removed. Based on these analyses, the St. Denis Bridge, area of excavation, as defined by the Post Remedial Action Report (PRAR) for the St. Denis Bridge Area - July 1999, can be used without restriction.
