Missouri-American Water Company recommends the final decisional document clearly state that it addresses both accessible and inaccessible areas. Further, the inaccessible areas should be cleaned up in the same manner as the accessible areas once they become available. Thus, the only difference between these two types of areas would be the placement of institutional controls on inaccessible areas until they become accessible and can be cleaned up by the federal government.

The final decisional document should also address how utilities will recover 100% of costs associated with relocation tasks due to clean up of accessible and inaccessible areas.
