Remedial Design

- MI <u>Plant 6W South of Bldg 101</u>; Pre-Design Investigation Report (PDIR) and Remedial Action Work Description (RAWD) finalized.
 Letter of Assessability from MI received.
 <u>Plant 7N/S PDIR out for regulator review.</u>
 - Plant 7W sampling in-progress.
 - South of Anglerodt VPs Thomas & Proetz PDIR comment resolution in-progress. Gunther North sampling continues
- West of Broadway VPs Sampling complete, except for one property

Remedial Action

- Backfill meeting w/ EPA, MDNR and MI held 21 June.
- MI Plant 6W South of Bldg 101; RA underway, sheetpile installation complete and 700 cy excavated from Area 1, currently in FSS. Some material will be used for backfill.
- Post Remedial Action Reports (PRARs) 3 in progress, Plant 1, Plant 7E, and DT 6/7 (Heintz Steel / Midwest Waste.
- Rail Shipments 2,680 cy this FY; shipping to resume. (5,000 cy planned for FY04).

- Remedial Design Re-evaluating Phase 6 Sheetpile design criteria; smaller/cheaper? Meet with RR next week to coordinate.
- Removal Actions
 - Phase 2/3 83,000+ cy total shipped to date.
 - · No activities currently.
 - · SU-35 utilized for water storage basins.
 - Phase 4/5 29,000+ cy shipped to date.
 - . SU-38 and 39; backfilling.
 - · SU-40; in confirmation.
 - · SU-42; gross excavation.
 - Coldwater Creek Still tentatively in AUG. Ameren/UE to complete e/o JUL.
 - Phase 6 RR scheduled to complete their signal line relocation by e/o AUG.
 - Water Storage / Water Treatment
 - · Basically no water being retained on site, currently.
 - 23 batches discharged this spring (~100,000 gal / batch)
 - Rail Shipments off SLAPS this FY
 - 78,000 cy shipped to date / 85,000 cy planned.



- SLAPS VP's
 - Assessment of the 30 DoE remediated properties. Complete; issue after ROD.
 - Characterizations On-going.
 - Designs are on hold in FY04
 - 56/57/58/59/1C & Pershall & I-270 ROW + 9/10/11/12 & Ballfield hotspots
 - Utility Support 15 this FY in N. Cty; mostly along haul road ROW.
 - VP-13 Started Jun 15; confirmation in-progress. 950 cy estimated.
 - Rail Shipments from VP's No shipments planned for FY04, however...


