 <u>Plant 7W</u> sampling complete. PDIR in progress.
- South of Anglerodt VPs –
 Thomas & Proetz
 PDIR finalized. Design out for regulator review.
 Gunther- Sampling complete. PDIR in progress.
- West of Broadway VPs Sampling complete.

Remedial Action

- MI Plant 6W South of Bidg 101 Excavation 90% complete. Areas
 2 & 3 in verification. 3,036 cy excavated. (appx. 500 cy to be reused).
- Post Remedial Action Reports (PRARs) 4 in progress, <u>Plant 1</u>, <u>Plant 7E</u>, <u>City of Venice (McKinley Bridge)</u> and <u>DT 6/7 (Heintz Steel / Midwest Waste)</u>.

 - SU-35 being utilized for one water storage basin.
 - Phase 4/5 ~45,000 cy shipped to date; SU-41 in-progress.
 - Coldwater Creek COMPLETE
 - Phase 6 RR signal line relocation complete.
 - Water Storage / Water Treatment
 - · Minimum water being retained on site, currently.
 - 25th batch recently discharged.
 - Rail Shipments off SLAPS this FY



Summary of September 10, 2004 Meeting

<u>Committee Members Present:</u> Jack Frauenhoffer, Ric Cavanagh, Sally Price, Michelle Morgenstern, Tom Manning, Jan Titus

The following comments are in addition to the handouts provided by USACE at the meeting.

Page 4 – PDIR is the Pre Design Investigation Report

Page 5 - 11,000 cy in situ taken out of Coldwater Creek. The site is in very good shape regarding status of water.

Page 6 – Lots of economic development. Therefore there have been 19 utility support requests at the site

Page 8 – New regulations have been received, our site should be granted an exemption to the regs. An additional \$13,000 has been sent to the state for the Cooperative Agreement. That brings the total for this agreement to about \$373,000 for the year. Funding will likely be under Continuing Resolutions (CRA's) for the near term, possibly until April.

Page 9 – Re:ROD – Financial projections needed to be redone since they had been based on 2001 numbers. All parties have seen the Draft-Final. However, the Army has not signed off on it. Once signed, EPA has 30 days to give final approval. Larry Erickson indicated that the State may still have some issues with the ROD. There will be no further public review on the ROD. Hopefully, the Oversight Committee will get a briefing on the ROD at the October meeting.

Other General Business - The visit by the Assistant Secretary of the Army went well. Sharon reported that it is not likely that St. Louis will receive any new money in the remainder of the fiscal year.
