## Progress Report St. Louis Downtown Site (SLDS)



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#### Remedial Design

- MI <u>Plant 7N/S</u> PDIR Rev 0 issued. Design in progress.
   <u>Plant 7W</u> sampling complete. PDIR in USACE review.
- South of Anglerodt VPs –
   Thomas & Proetz PDIR & Design finalized.

   Gunther- Sampling complete. PDIR in progress.
- West of Broadway VPs Sampling complete.

#### Remedial Action

- MI Plant 6W South of Bldg 101 Excavation 95% complete. Areas
   1 & 2 returned to MI. Soil nailing underway for remaining portion of Area
   3 along Destrehan. 3,200 cy excavated. (appx. 500 cy to be reused).
- Post Remedial Action Reports (PRARs) 4 in progress: <u>Plant 7E, City of Venice (McKinley Bridge)</u>, <u>DT 6/7 (Heintz Steel / Midwest Waste) and Plant 10</u>. <u>Plant 1 PRAR finalized</u>.
- Rail Shipments 6190 cy shipped. (5,000 cy planned for FY04).

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# Progress Report St. Louis Airport Site (SLAPS)



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- Remedial Design Phase 6 Sheetpile wall design being coordinated w/ NS-RR.
- Removal Actions
  - Main activity is grading/seeding of drainage ditch to CWC.
  - Phase 2/3 89,000+ cy total shipped to date (46,000+ cy in FY04).
  - Phase 4/5 45,000 cy shipped to date; SU-41 in-progress.
  - Phase 6 11,700 cy shipped. Sheetpile wall construction next.
  - Water Storage / Water Treatment
    - 25 batches discharged this construction season.
  - Rail Shipments off SLAPS in FY04
    - 106,800 cy shipped to date / 85,000 cy planned for FY04.


Hazelwood Interim Storage Site (HISS)/Latty Avenue / SLAPS VPS

  - VPs 1L, 8C and 40a Parcel preparing Draft Summary Report
  - Rail Shipments off HISS No shipments planned for FY04
- SLAPS VP's
  - Assessment of the 30 DoE remediated properties. Complete; issue after ROD.
  - Characterizations On-going.
  - Designs are on hold in FY04
    - 56/57/58/59/1C & Pershall & I-270 ROW + 9/10/11/12 & Ballfield hotspots
  - Utility Support 1 this FY in N. Cty; 20 in FY04...
  - Rail Shipments from VP's No shipments planned for FY04, however...
    - ~1,800 cy shipped from VPs 10, 13 and 4C/5C.
