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Summary of Meeting

December 10, 2004

The following comments are in addition to the handouts provided by USACE staff at the meeting.

Page 4 – 262 cy taken out of Thomas and Proetz (There still is a small area behind the building where lumber is stored). One rail car detailed which has slowed some of the work in this area.

Page 5 – Staff met with airport on 2/7 re: final grading and future maintenance/back out strategy (the airport itself is considered a VP property). SLAPS should be done in FY 06. REQUEST: Give committee an update on the airport area (size, characterization)

Page 6 – HISS basically in on hold. Staff did coordinate some services with MSD

Page 8 – LTS: Debbie Roush will taking this over. Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA): state requested that they be a signatory, especially regarding LTS. The request was declined because of the resulting delays due to legal reviews.

Committee and staff agree that we need to get DoE actively involved in the LTS process once the ROD is signed.

Funding: Nationally, FUSRAP got an extra \$25 million in budget. St. Louis could easily use \$5 million more. This means that the national FUSRAP allocation jumped from \$140 million to \$165 million. St. Louis will get \$48.5 million with an additional \$5-10 million possible (which would allow SLAPS to be completed).

Staffing: Jacqui has two months detail downtown. Sharon will be on detail for three months starting in April.



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
