**ST. LOUIS FUSRAP OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

**Summary of Meeting**

**March 12, 1999**

The following notes are in addition to the handouts (see attached).

**Page 4** - Cost of water treatment is 5 cents per gallon. Map at the end of packet details the sections of SLAPS. East end is almost complete. Project will proceed in the following order:

- Radium Pits
- Northwest Central
- Southwest Central
- West End
- Rail Loadout
- Railroad Right of Way

This basically reflects an upstream to downstream pattern.

**Page 5** - Futura still very concerned about expanding into HISS area. Wants the work speeded up if possible.

**Page 6** - There may not even be enough to do design work on VP's in FY 99. Better use of contractors is to do SLAPS and SLDS.

**Page 7** - Plant 2 to be completed by end of summer. "8500" refers to the total cyds.

**Page 8** - ARAR's being reviewed by Omaha. PCOC (risk assessment) being reviewed, anticipate some modifications. ECO means ecological.

March 11, the draft MOU between DOE and USACE is being reviewed. (DOE to assume management two years after final USACE close out. The first five year review is to be done by USACE). *The Committee requested that it have input into this process. Sharon to supply Committee with names to write to.*

Disposal cost is approximately 33% of project cost. (Hopefully, this cost will go down over time).

**Page 9** - SLDS open house had approximately 35040 people.

**Page 10** - Old Taskers:

- 1) Cost for water treatment is 5 cents per gallon.
- 2) NRC can regulate 11 E2 waste generated from 1978 on. Therefore NRC cannot regulate our project. EPA agrees that it doesn't make good policy sense.

***New Taskers:***

- 1) MOU - DOE contact address
- 2) Move trailers to Super Valu lots??
- 3) Who were bidders for disposal contract?

***Appropriations:*** Tom Horgan from Congressman Talent's office raised the issue of current and future appropriations. St. Louis has 50% of the FUSRAP waste but gets only 33% of the money. Rep. Talent to request more dollars from the Energy and Water Subcommittee. Will also seek bi-partisan support from other Missouri Congressmen, Senators.

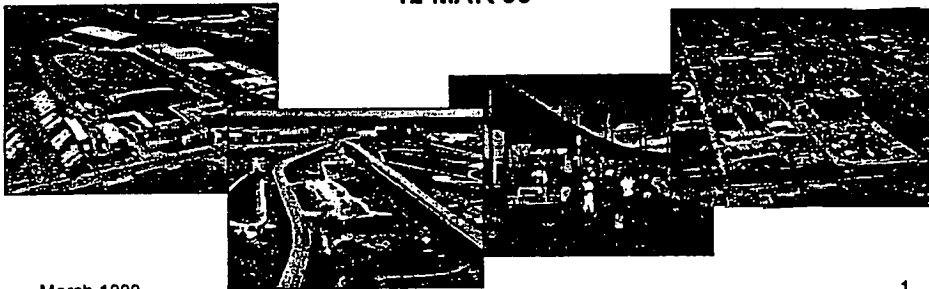

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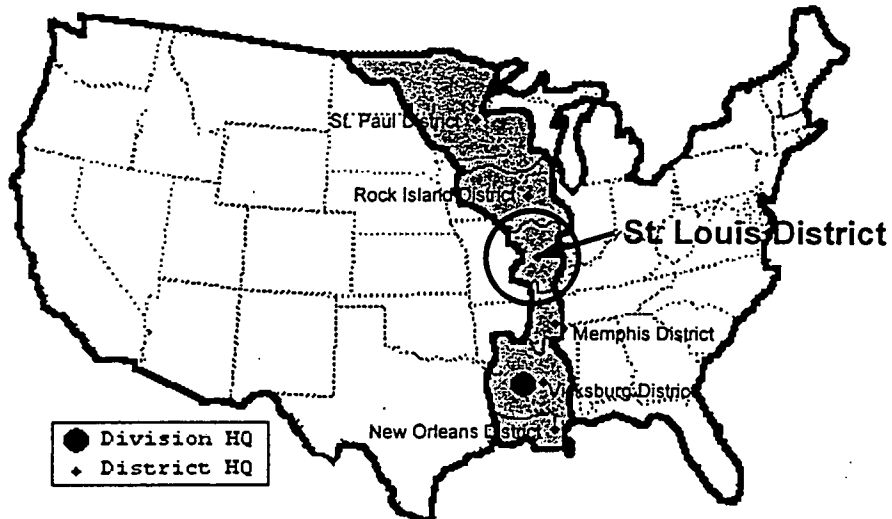

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## Progress Report St. Louis Airport Site (SLAPS)



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- **EE/CA Action Memo/Responsiveness Summary - Received**
  - Distribution of Final EE/CA within 2 weeks
- **North Ditch / Sedimentation Basin Construction ongoing**
  - North Ditch (including Sediment Trap) - 16,148 cyds - 63%
  - Sedimentation Basin - 13,978 cyds - 90%
    - Placing liner week of 22 March (weather permitting)
    - Treated and released 650,000 gallons of water - S Ditch
- **SLAPS East End Construction ongoing**
  - 8,588 cy by PRAC (Radian) -95%
    - Prepared 800 cyds of asbestos for shipment
  - 20,000 cy by TERC (Stone & Webster) starting 1 MAY 99
    - Negotiating Task Order - RD (Complete) / RA (MAR 99)
- **Rail Shipments off SLAPS and Eva**
  - 457 gondola railcars shipped to date (32,447 cyds)

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## Progress Report Hazelwood Interim Storage Site (HISS)/Latty Avenue

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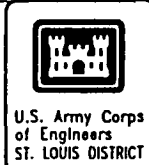
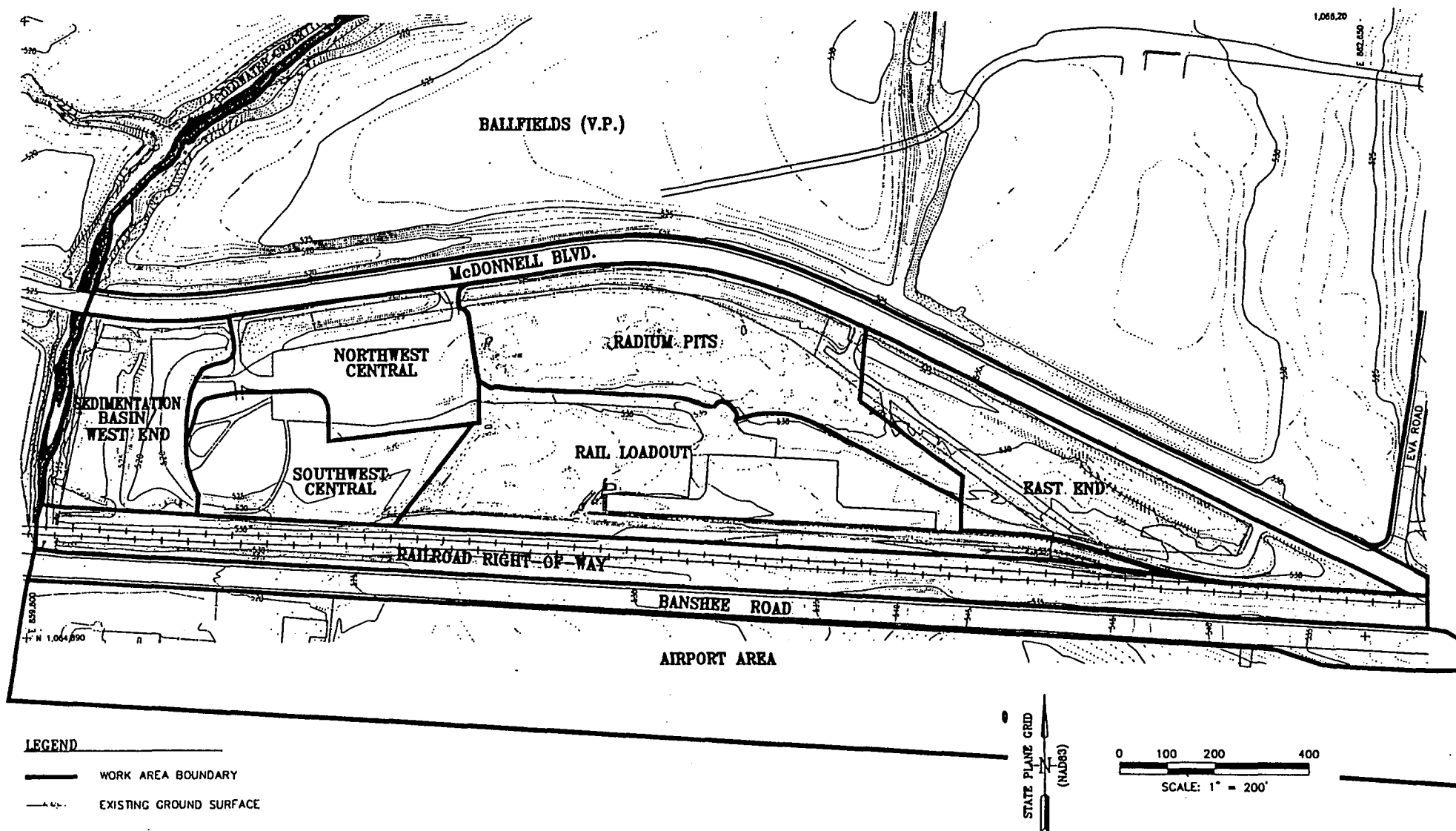
