The following comments are in addition to the information in the handouts provided by USACE at the meeting.

Page 4 – We will likely exceed the 55,000cyd expectation this year. Water treatment is the key issue. USACE met with DNR on 8/29 regarding permitting for water treatment. DNR will respond within 30 days.

- Page 5 DOE remediation assessment is a low priority. VP 22 the Corps approved replacement of the concrete pad (copy of letter distributed to Committee).
- Page 6 Remedial design on hold due to funding restrictions. Corps has met with Mallinckrodt regardgin de-commissioning.
- Page 7 North County ROD: apparently the decision on clean up criteria will be made by Division office in Vicksburg. They will need to be educated about St. Louis community needs and expectations. In a related matter, New Jersey has established very restrictive clean up standards. This may set a good precedent for our project.

Cateway to Excellence

- Remedial Design
 - Work Descriptions for Phases 4 / 5 and Phase 6 Next step is regulator review for Phase 4/5
 (after North County ROD) and USACE 90% review for Phase 6. Phase 6 is currently being
 coordinated with the railroad.


