The following comments are in addition to the handouts provided by the USACE staff at the meeting.

Page 4 – The bike path was completed in April

Page 5 – Meeting today with Stone Container re: some property changes. Sharon commented that there is a need to get some projects under way so that funds are not cut (cuts may be made on projects "planned but not implemented.")

Page 6 – CSC=Coldwater Creek. Water treatment is working very well. Some funds have been moved from other sites to keep this project going. Staff have requested \$1-4 million more for this year.

Page 8 – DOT proposals would require more expensive packaging and/or intermodels. Therefore, staff are requesting exemption (since our materials aren't heavily contaminated).

Page 9 – Many comments received from state and EPA. Still targeting a ROD in this fiscal year.












Volume Removed Using Environmental Documents
