

Progress Report St. Louis Airport Site (SLAPS)



Gateway to Excellence

- Investigation Briefed the Airport Authority on results of the partial VP14a / IA13 investigation.
- Remedial Design
 - Work Descriptions for Phases 4 / 5 and Phase 6 Next step is regulator review for Phase 4/5
 (after North County ROD). USACE 90% review for Phase 6 is currently ongoing.
- Removal Actions
 - Began Phase I (IA5) excavation 10 DEC 01 75,000 cyds expected
 - 58,000 cyds removed to date. Phase 1 removal continues.
 - . 3 of the 5 Survey Units have been cleared / backfilled to date,
 - Removal of the Radium Pits sump area (Survey Unit 21A) is ongoing.
 - Status of water treatment system Pilot test and Bench test status
 - Pilot scale test (15,000 gallons) for water treatment Ongoing for batch 5 of 7.
 - · Large scale pilot test (130,000 gallons) which began 9 SEP is ongoing.
 - Bench tests results @ 30 OCT (This will provide a determination if we can (1) reduce the need
 to haul sludge for each test or (2) if a two stage process is more effective for the treatment of Se.




