The following comments are in addition to the handouts provided by USACE staff at the meeting.

Page 5 – The NPDS permit was tied to the piles. Since the piles are gone, Corps staff do not see the need to continue monitoring until more excavation is done. The March 21 GIFREHC review is on the district level.

Page 7 – The Thorium clean up criteria is the last issue. At the March 26 briefing of Vicksburg staff, St. Louis will request public release of the document. The signed cooperative agreement between USACE and MDNR was just received in the mail on 3/14/03.

Page 9 – The Five Year Review for CERCLA must be done. Jacqui Mattingly is coordinating interviews.

Page 12 – It should be noted that a presentation was also recently made to the North Broadway Business Association.
