Thank you for providing graphic and photographic documentation for the remaining extant buildings associated with the historic Mallinckrodt Chemical Works, located in the vicinity of Mallinckrodt, Destrehan, and Second Streets in St. Louis, Missouri. This includes floor plans and photographs for Buildings 25, 100, 116, 117, 700, 704, 705, 706, 707, 708, and "K" of the St. Louis Downtown Site (SLDS) Mallinckrodt Chemical, Incorporated, Plants 1, 6, and 7. Mr. Craig Kenkel no longer works directly with the Historic American Building Survey (HABS) program and has assigned oversight of this documentation project to me (HABS No. MO-1929/96-MO-008). I understand that five buildings from in the "50 series" were demolished in Fall 1996 and, given approval by the National Park Service and Missouri State Historic Preservation Office, the remaining structures listed above will be razed in April 1997.

I have reviewed the floor plans and documentary photographs for the remaining 11 buildings, submitted to this office on February 20. They provide sufficient graphical information about the current state of these historic resources and I am returning them for the completion of this HABS recordation project (No. MO-1929). The buildings, themselves, are no longer necessary and demolition may proceed, as planned.
