The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), St. Louis District, issued a Proposed Plan summarizing cleanup alternatives and the supporting Feasibility Study for Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) areas at the lowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) on April 22, 2011. The Proposed Plan identifies *Soil Alternative 4, Excavation of Contaminated Soil with Physical Treatment and Off-Site Disposal*, and *Structures Alternative 3, Decontamination/Replacement of Christians and Management of Chris*

Structures, as the USACE's preferred remedy

USACE encourages public input to help select one cleanup alternative each for soil and structures in the FUSRAP areas. The final remedy for soil and structures will not be selected until after full consideration of all public and government agency comments. The final remedy will be documented in a Record of Decision for the FUSRAP areas at the IAAAP.
