**CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING
USACE Dredge Potter
Upper Mississippi River mile 0 - 300**

1. The US Army Corps of Engineers Dredge Potter continues to perform channel maintenance dredging at various locations on the Upper Mississippi River from mile 0 to 300.0. The USACE Dredge Potter is currently working at mile 171, with additional assignments expected in the St. Louis area from mile 185 to 167 over the next 3 to 4 weeks.
2. The Dredge Potter and its attendant plant, to include tender boats, small boats, barges, & pipeline, etc., will work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Dredged material will be placed using pontoon pipeline or self-floating pipeline to either side of the channel.
3. The Dredge will monitor VHF-FM radio channels 13 and 16. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
