**TRANSIT ADVISORY**  
**Above Lock 24, UMR Mile 275.0 - 274.0**

1. Mariners should exercise caution if waiting along the right descending bank from mile 275.0 to mile 274.0 for lockage at Lock 24. Surveys indicate a shoal of less than 9-ft of depth, at minimum pool, starting 250-ft right of the sailing.
2. From mile 275.0 to 274.0, the Navigation Channel is over 600-ft wide and at least 11-ft deep at minimum pool.
