**CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING
USACE Dredge Potter
St. Louis District**

1. Commencing on 28 January 2019 and continuing until further notice, the US Army Corps of Engineers Dredge Potter will perform channel maintenance dredging at various locations within the St. Louis District.
2. The Dredge Potter will start work in the vicinity of mile 171 UMR with placement outside the red buoy line. Additional assignments will be performed at mile 173, 169, and 168.
3. The Dredge Potter and its attendant plant, to include tender boats, small boats, barges and pipeline, etc., work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When dredging, removed material is pumped through a pontoon pipeline or self-floating pipeline, which may be crossing the channel, and is placed outside of the navigation channel.
4. The Dredge Potter may be contacted on VHF-FM radio channels 13 and 16. Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made with the Dredge Potter.
5. Additional updates will be provided as work progresses.
