**LOCKAGE & CREW CHANGE SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS (COVID-19)**  
**Lock and Dam 24 and 25**  
**Upper Mississippi River Mile 273.4 and 241.4**

Due to concerns regarding the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and effective immediately for MISSISSIPPI RIVER LOCKS 24 and 25:

1. No industry personnel shall be allowed inside USACE lock control houses or other buildings during crew changes, except in the case of medical emergency.
2. Crew changes will still be allowed, but industry personnel must go directly from the vehicle to the motor vessel. At both facilities (Locks 24/25) the crew van will be required to park outside of the exterior fenced area during the crew change.
3. Also effective immediately Locks 24 and 25 will not accept incoming or outgoing boat mail.
4. Industry personnel will be required to use their own facilities while navigating through the lock.
5. Changes are effective immediately and until further notice.
6. All navigation interest should be alert for, and abide by, any special instructions that may be issued by the Lockmaster.
