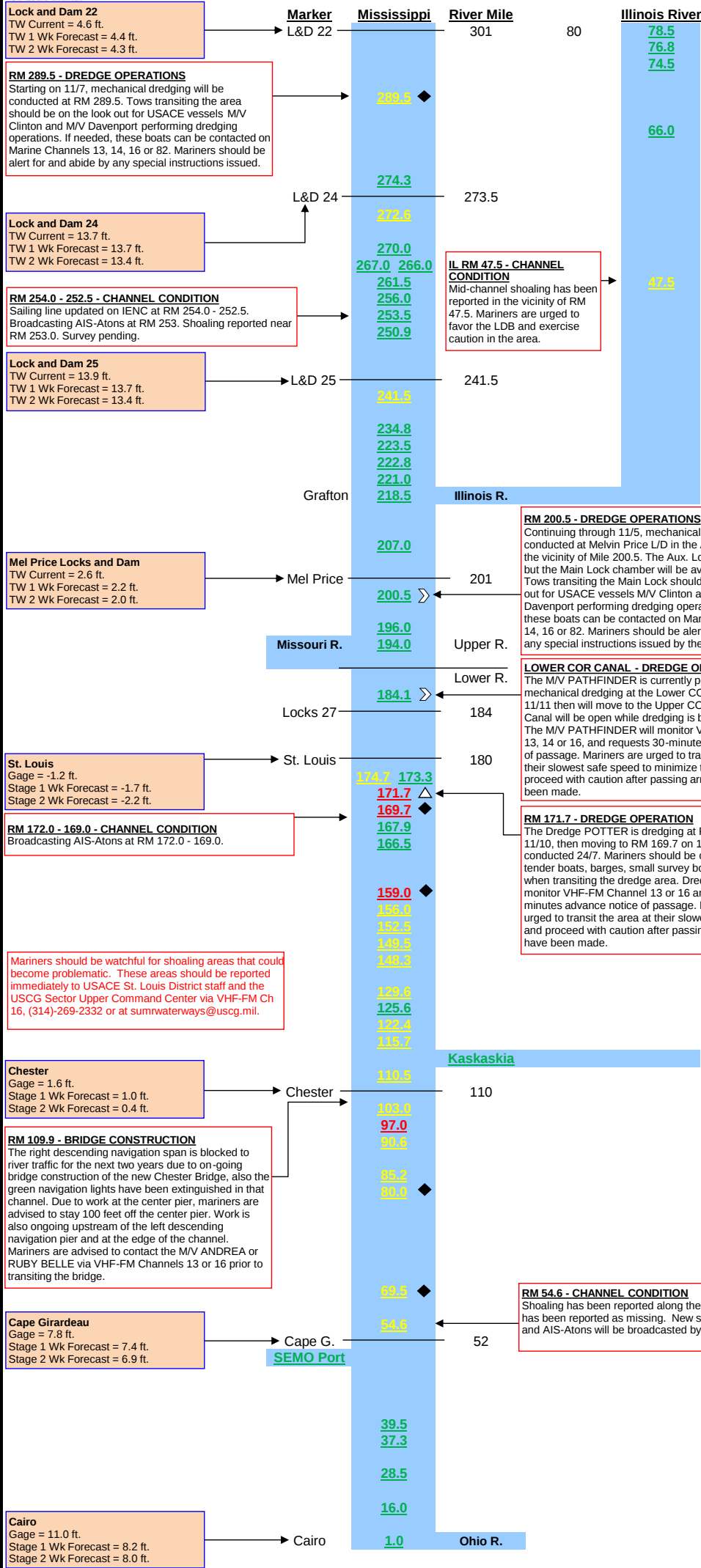

Dredge Goetz: Out of District.

Mechanical Dredge - M/V Clinton & M/V Davinport: Dredging the Melvin Price L&D Aux Chamber until the end of today. Moving to RM 289.5 for dredging 11/7-11/8.
