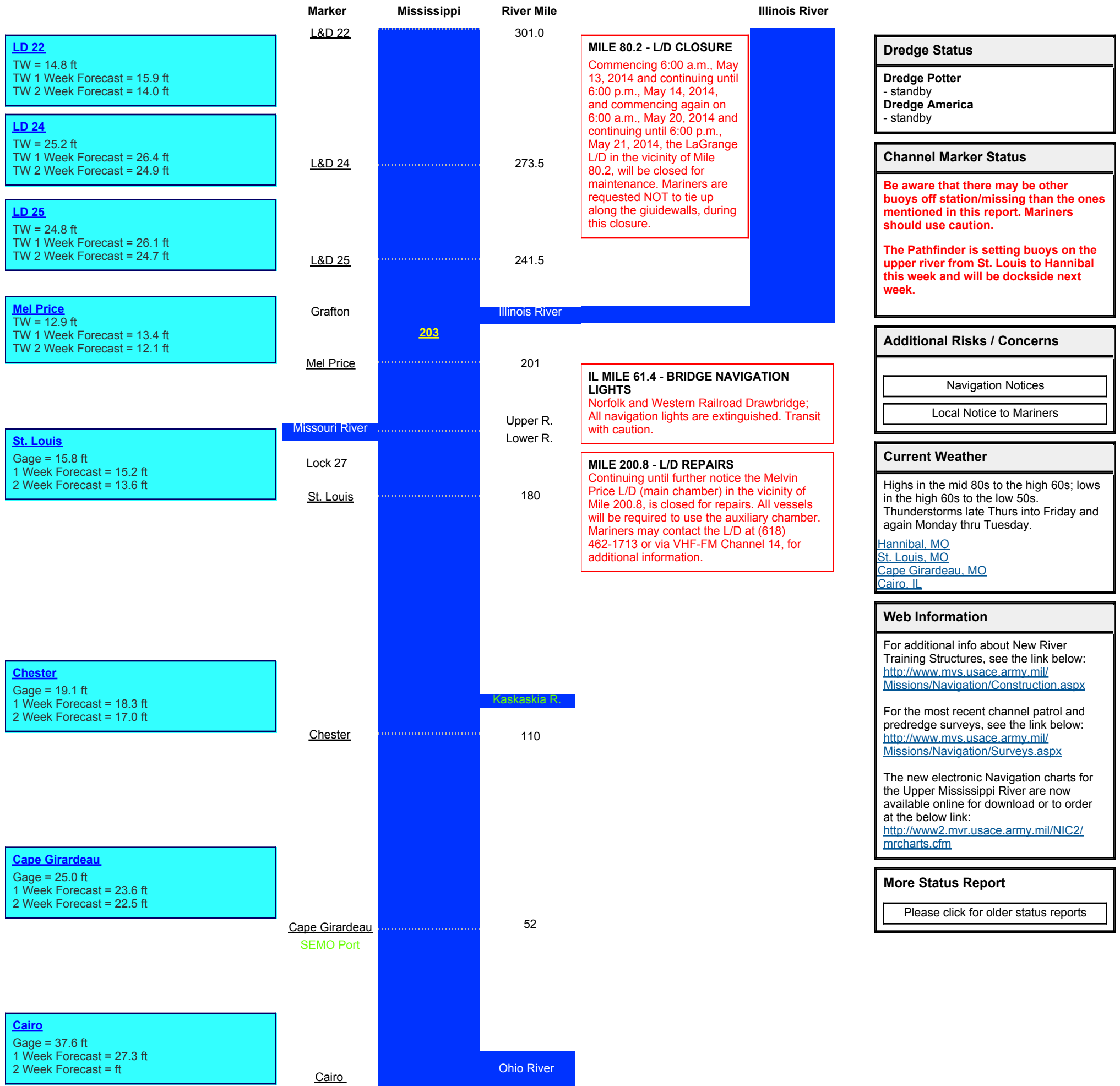




Navigation Channel Condition Status Report - 7 May 2014
