

Information Paper Lake Shelbyville, IL

Flood Control Acts of 1944 and 1958

Operation and Maintenance (FRM)

Location and Description: The project provides flood control, water supply, recreation, conservation of fish and wildlife, and water quality control and augments navigation flows downstream on the Kaskaskia River. The lake extends northeastward to approximately river mile 275 through Shelby, Moultrie, Douglas, and Coles counties in Illinois.

- FY22 President's Budget: \$17,965k, IIJA \$8,825k (Baseline level: \$5,818k).
 - Operate and maintain project at an acceptable level of service.
 - Complete storm damage repairs -shoreline repairs, levee repairs, and road repairs.
 - Sustainability Replacement of comfort stations, shower buildings, fish cleaning stations, lift station, leaking water and sewer lines,
 - Complete dam bridge and Tainter gate repairs and painting.
 - Perform boundary maintenance, periodic inspection, and security upgrades.
 - IIJA Complete damage repairs, shoreline revetment, replace radio tower, fishery rehabilitation work, maintenance for recreation areas, and update to the current Water Control Manual.
- Activities after FY22 (top items listed)
 - Operate and maintain project.
 - Restore navigation depth to the facilities at Sullivan Marina.
 - Road Maintenance.
 - Replace recreational facilities to meet ADA requirements/retire buildings.
 - Provide operations and maintenance, dam safety, water control, and real estate for compliance management.
- Status
 - Implement sustainability measures at project office and visitor center to reduce energy costs
