Location: The project area is located in Pacific, Missouri, within the Meramec River Basin, approximately 35 miles southwest of St. Louis, Missouri.

Description: The city of Pacific is experiencing significant impacts from recurrent Meramec River flooding. The city has requested assistance from the St. Louis District to evaluate structural and non-structural flood risk reduction measures in the flood prone areas of the community. The city experienced two floods of record within a 16-month period, which damaged homes, businesses and critical infrastructure.

Status: St. Louis District is anticipating Federal Interest Determination approval in September 2023.

Importance: The flood of record in December 2015, located within the declared area for federal disaster assistance (DR-4250-MO), impacted a significant number of homes, businesses and critical infrastructure both within the city limits and just outside the city but within St. Louis County. Sixteen months later in May 2017, record levels were recorded in the city, which was again located within the declared area for federal disaster assistance (DR-4317-MO).

Authority: Section 205 of the 1948 Flood Control Act, as amended.


