Location: The project area is located in the city of Eureka, Missouri, within the Meramec River Basin, approximately 30 miles southwest of St. Louis, Missouri.

Description: The city of Eureka is experiencing significant impacts from recurrent Meramec River flooding. The city has requested assistance from the St. Louis District to evaluate structural and non-structural flood risk reduction measures in the flood prone areas of the community. The city experienced two floods of record within a 16-month period, which damaged homes, businesses, schools and critical infrastructure.


Status: The feasibility study is being terminated at the request of the sponsor.

Importance: The flood of record in December 2015, located within the declared area for federal disaster assistance (DR-4250-MO), impacted more than 4% of homes in the city with more than \$2.2M in documented damages and estimated infrastructure damages of ~\$2M. Two-thirds of the historic downtown district was impacted. Sixteen months later in May 2017, record levels were recorded in the city, which was again located within the declared area for federal disaster assistance (DR-4317-MO).

Authority: Section 205 of the 1948 Flood Control Act, as amended.
